

My Meadow Hello Card

Card stock cuts for this project:

- Pool Party – 4-1/4" x 11" card base scored at 5-1/2"
- Granny Apple Green – 2" x 4-5/8" panel
- Soft Suede – 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" panel
- Whisper White – two Stitched So Sweetly die cuts, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)
- Parisian Blossoms Specialty Designer Series Paper – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel
- Brights 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper – 1-7/8" x 4-1/2" panel
- Pressed Petals Specialty Designer Series Paper – 1-3/8" x 4-1/4" panel

Instructions for the project:

1. Adhere the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel of Parisian Blossoms Specialty DSP to the front of the Pool Party card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Adhere the 1-7/8" x 4-1/2" panel of Granny Apple Green DSP from the Brights 6" x 6" DSP pack to the 2" x 4-5/8" panel of Ganny Apple Green card stock with SNAIL.
3. Adhere the layered DSP panel to the card front with SNAIL.
4. Adhere the 1-3/8" x 4-1/4" panel of Pressed Petals Specialty DSP to the 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" panel of Soft Suede card stock with SNAIL.
5. Adhere the layered DSP panel to the card front with SNAIL.
6. Wrap a strand of Linen Thread around the card front twice and tie a bow.
7. Stamp the images from the **My Meadow** photopolymer stamp set in Soft Suede, Crumb Cake, Granny Apple Green, Pool Party, Gray Granite and Mango Melody inks on a panel of Whisper White card stock.
8. Cut the image out with the largest rectangle from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies.
9. Adhere the die cut to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Stamp the sentiment from the **Beauty Abounds** stamp set in Mango Melody ink on a panel of Whisper White card stock.
11. Cut the sentiment out with the smallest of the rectangle dies from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies.

12. Adhere the die cut sentiment to the card front with SNAIL at the top and Stampin' Dimensionals at the bottom.

13. Adhere one of the Granny Apple Green Glitter Enamel Dots next to the sentiment.



14. Stamp the images from the My Meadow stamp set in Granny Apple Green, Crumb Cake and Mango Melody inks on the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Whisper White card stock.

15. Adhere the panel inside the card base with SNAIL.
