### Royal Peacock Proud Of You Card

#### Card stock cuts for this project:

- Blueberry Bushel 4-1/4" x 11" card base scored at 5-1/2"
- Whisper White Stitched Rectangle die cut, Detailed Peacock die cut, Stitched Shapes die cut, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)
- Noble Peacock Specialty Designer Series Paper – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel
- Noble Peacock Foil Sheets four Detailed Peacock die cuts

### Instructions for the project:

- 1. Adhere the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel of the Noble Peacock Specialty DSP to the front of a Blueberry Bushel card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 2. Cut a panel of Whisper White card stock with the third largest of the Stitched Rectangle Dies.
- 3. Adhere the die cut to the card front with SNAIL.
- 4. Stamp the image from the *Royal Peacock* photopolymer stamp set in Blueberry Bushel ink on a panel of Whisper White card stock.
- 5. Stamp the feather image from the Royal Peacock stamp set in Old Olive ink over the tail feather area of the stamped image.
- 6. Color the body of the peacock with a Light Pretty Peacock Stampin' Blends Marker.
- 7. Cut the peacock image out with the coordinating Detailed Peacock Die.
- 8. Adhere the die cut image to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Cut a panel of Nobel Peacock Foil Sheets with the branch dies from the Detailed Peacock Dies. Cut the solid branch twice and the branch with the open leaves twice.
- 10. Snip the long stems off the ends of the branch die cuts and adher the die cuts with Glue Dots under the die cut peacock.
- 11. Stamp the sentiment from the Royal Peacock stamp set in Blueberry Bushel ink on a panel of Whisper White card stock.

12. Cut the sentiment out with the second smallest circle from the Stitched Shapes Dies.

- 13. Adhere the die cut sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals to the card front.
- 14. Adhere three Nobel Peacock Rhinestones to the card front around the sentiment.



- 15. Stamp the peacock image and feathers from the Royal Peacock stamp set in Blueberry Bushel and Old Olive inks on the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Whisper White card stock with SNAIL.
- 16. Adhere the panel inside the card base with SNAIL.
