## **Detailed Dogwood Hello Card**

## **Card Stock Cuts for this project:**

- Crumb Cake 4-1/4" x 11" card base scored at 5-1/2"
- Petal Pink Wild Fern die cut
- Basic White Scalloped Contours die cut, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)
- Sunny Days Designer Series Paper 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" panel
- One Horse Open Sleigh 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel, 1/2" x 4" strip (inside card)



## **Instructions for this project:**

- 1. Adhere the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel of One Horse Open Sleigh 6" x 6" DSP (Online Exclusive item) to the front of a Crumb Cake card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 2. Adhere the 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" panel of Sunny Days DSP (Sale-a-bration item, available Jan 4) to the card front with Stampin' Seal.
- 3. Wrap a length of Linen Thread around the card front three times and then tie a bow.
- 4. Stamp the flower image from the *Detailed Dogwood* stamp set (Sale-a-bration item, available Jan 4) in Granny Apple Green ink on a panel of Basic White card stock.
- 5. Color the image with Light and Dark Lemon Lolly and Light Granny Apple Green and Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends Markers.
- 6. Cut around the image with the second largest rectangle die from the Scalloped Contours Dies.
- 7. Ink the dotted image from the Detailed Dogwood stamp set in Crumb Cake ink, stamp it on scrap paper and then stamp it across the panel. Repeat across the panel.
- 8. Adhere the die cut panel with Stampin' Dimensionals to the card front.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment from the *Softly Sophisticated* photopolymer stamp set (Sale-a-bration item, available Jan 4) in Pecan Pie ink on a panel of Petal Pink card stock.
- 10. Cut around the sentiment with the smallest rectangle die from the Wild Fern Dies (available Ian 4).
- 11. Adhere the die cut sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals to the card front.
- 12. Adhere two of the Pecan Pie gems from the Opaque Faceted Gems (Sale-a-bration item, available Jan 4) to card front.



- 13. Adhere the 1/2" x 4" strip of One Horse Open DSP to the bottom of the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Basic White card stock with Stampin' Seal.
- 14. Adhere the Basic White panel inside of the card base with Stampin' Seal.
