

# Sunrise Sailing Congratulations Card

## Card Stock Cuts for this project:

- Thick Basic White – 4-1/4" x 11" card base scored at 5-1/2"
- Lemon Lolly – Spotlight On Nature die cut
- Poppy Parade – Textured Notes die cut
- Basic White – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel, Sunrise Sailing die cut, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)

## Instructions for this project:

1. Stamp the lined image from the **Sunrise Sailing** photopolymer stamp set (Online Exclusive item) in Balmy Blue ink on the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel of Basic White card stock.
2. Emboss the panel with the Sunrise Sailing Hybrid Embossing Folder (Online Exclusive item).
3. Use a Blending Brush to apply Balmy Blue ink to the "water" area on the embossed panel.
4. Adhere the embossed panel to the front of a Thick Basic White card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Cut a panel of Lemon Lolly card stock with the second largest dashed circle die from the Spotlight On Nature Dies.
6. Adhere the die cut circle to the card front with Stampin' Seal.
7. Stamp the sailboat images from the Sunrise Sailing stamp set in Gray Granite, Poppy Parade and Daffodil Delight inks on a panel of Basic White card stock.
8. Cut and emboss the image with the Sunrise Sailing Hybrid Embossing Folder.
9. Adhere the sailboat to the card front with Mini Glue Dots.
10. Stamp the bird image from the Sunrise Sailing stamp set three times in Gray Granite ink across the card front.
11. Stamp the sentiment from the Sunrise Sailing stamp set in VersaMark ink on a panel of Poppy Parade card stock, sprinkle it with white embossing powder from the Basics Wow! Embossing Powder and then heat emboss it.
12. Cut the sentiment out with the long, narrow die from the Textured Notes Dies (Online Exclusive item).
13. Slide the die over about 1/2", line up the stitches and then cut the sentiment a little shorter.
14. Adhere the die cut sentiment to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
15. Adhere three of the Riverside Irregular Pearls to the card front.



16. Stamp the water and bird images from the Sunrise Sailing stamp set in Balmy Blue and Gray Granite inks the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Basic White card stock.
17. Adhere the panel inside the card base with Stampin' Seal.
