

# Sweet Words & Labels Old Friends Are The Best Friends Card

Card Stock Cuts for this project:

- Mossy Meadow – 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base scored at 4-1/4"
- Early Espresso – 4" x 5-1/4" panel, three Perennial Postage die cuts, two Sweet Old Friends die cuts
- Very Vanilla – three 1-3/8" x 2-1/8" panels, Perennial Postage die cut, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)
- Silly Old Bear Designer Series Paper – 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" panel, four Sweet Old Friends die cuts

## Instructions for this project:

1. Adhere the 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" panel of patterned paper from the Silly Old Bear DSP (Online Exclusive item) to a panel of Early Espresso card stock with Stampin' Seal.
2. Wrap a strand of Linen Thread around the panel twice and tie a bow.
3. Adhere the layered panel to the front of a Mossy Meadow card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Cut a panel of Early Espresso card stock with the Perennial Postage Die that measures approximately 1-1/2" x 2-1/4" three times.
5. Adhere the panels of Very Vanilla card stock with Stampin' Seal to the die cuts.
6. Adhere the layered panels to the card front with Stampin' Seal.
7. Cut panels of Early Espresso and Crumb Cake card stocks with the stump dies from the Sweet Old Friends Dies (Online Exclusive item restocking around June 22).
8. Adhere the die cuts with Multipurpose Liquid Glue together and then to the card front.
9. Cut a panel of Silly Old Bear DSP with the coordinating dies from the Sweet Old Friends Dies.
10. Adhere the die cuts to the card front with Stampin' Seal.
11. Stamp the sentiment from the **Sweet Words & Labels** stamp set (Online Exclusive item) in Early Espresso ink on a panel of Very Vanilla card stock.
12. Cut the image with the small narrow banner die from the Perennial Postage Dies.
13. Cut a panel of Early Espresso card stock with the smaller arrow die from the Sweet Old Friends Dies twice.
14. Adhere the die cuts to the back of the sentiment with Stampin' Seal.
15. Adhere the sentiment to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
16. Adhere two dots from the Earthy Matte Dots to the card front.



17. Stamp the Winnie The Pooh image from the Sweet Old Friends stamp set in Early Espresso ink on the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Very Vanilla card stock.
18. Color the image with Light and Dark Golden Glow and Hydrangea Hue Stampin' Blends Markers.
19. Adhere the panel inside the card base with Stampin' Seal.
