

Noel Tidings Season's Greetings Wreath Card

Card Stock Cuts for this project:

- Crumb Cake – 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base scored at 4-1/4"
- Real Red – three Noel Tidings die cuts
- Cherry Cobbler – Noel Tidings die cut
- Basic White – six Noel Tidings die cuts, 4" x 5-1/4" panel (inside card)
- Alpine Winter Designer Series Paper – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel
- Peaceful Pine Two-Tone Cardstock – two Noel Tidings die cuts

Instructions for this project:

1. Adhere the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" panel of patterned paper from the Alpine Winter DSP (Online Exclusive item) to the front of a Crumb Cake card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Cut a panel of Two-Tone Peaceful Pine Cardstock two times (one light and one dark) with the wreath die from the Noel Tidings Dies.
3. Adhere the two wreaths to the card front with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the pinecone images from the **Noel Tidings** stamp set in Early Espresso ink on a panel of Basic White cards stock.
5. Color the images with Light and Dark Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends Markers.
6. Cut the pinecones out with the coordinating Noel Tidings Dies.
7. Adhere the pinecone die cuts with Mini Glue Dots to the card front.
8. Cut a panel of Real Red card stock three times with the berries die from the Noel Tidings Dies.
9. Adhere the berries with Mini Glue Dots to the card front.
10. Adhere a length of Gold Striped 3/8" Mesh Ribbon to the card front with Stampin' Seal in a "z".
11. Stamp the sentiment from the Noel Tidings stamp set in VersaMark ink on a panel of Cherry Cobbler card stock, sprinkle it with gold embossing powder from the Metallics Wow! Embossing Powders and then heat emboss it.
12. Cut the sentiment out with the coordinating banner die from the Noel Tidings Dies.
13. Adhere the sentiment with Stampin' Dimensionals to the card front.



14. Stamp the sentiment from the Noel Tidings stamp set in Cherry Cobbler ink on the 4" x 5-1/4" panel of Basic White card stock.
15. Stamp the pinecone image from the Noel Tidings stamp set two times in Early Espresso ink on the Basic White panel.
16. Color the pinecones with Light and Dark Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends Markers.
17. Adhere the panel inside the card base with Stampin' Seal.
